All participating artists will receive a box of high-quality chalk pastels, a professional print and digital image of your work and complimentary refreshments throughout the day.

From our applicants, we will select a limited number compensated Featured Artists who will be expected to provide both advice and guidance to the competition artists and judge the final winning entries. Please indicate below if you would like to be considered as a Featured Artist. Featured Artists' squares will be sponsored. Featured artists are obligated to include their sponsor's name in 6 inch tall letters on the bottom of their art square. Please add your sponsors name to your square as soon as you start. You can change or embellish it later if needed.

We welcome submissions from all levels of experience - we want to FILL the streets with all kinds of chalk art!

Artist Application

Artists will be provided a 10'x10' space in which an 8'x8' piece of unique chalk art should be produced. This a rain or shine event. In the event of rain we will attempt to provide as much cover as possible but artists should be prepared for all weathers.

Requirements

- 1. All Artwork produced MUST be suitable for a multi age audience and should not depict violence; nudity; or profanity.
- 2. No political statements; slogans; trademarks or advertising
- 3. Artists must supply their own chalk based materials which should be water soluble and nontoxic. Oil pastels; paint and non-chalk mediums are not acceptable
- 4. A design brief written or drawn must be provided by **March 15th**, **2018** Featured Artist selections will be based on these designs.
- 5. Sponsor information should be visible at all times
- 6. Artists must complete their Image by 1pm
- 7. All art work must be contained within the allocated space
- 8. Artists may not accept monetary donations from onlookers
- 9. Artwork may not violate copyright law
